Planning

Decision from Maldon District Council: 14 Maldon Road – proposed loft conversion with velux windows to front and rear elevations – Approved.

New application:

Goldhanger Village Hall – amendments to approved application, frontage extension to Village Hall – Supported.

Councillors noted that the following Appeal to the Planning Inspectorate has been dismissed: Falcon Hall Little Totham Road – Proposed conversion of nissen hut to residential dwelling.

Finance

The internal audit has now been completed and details of the Parish Council's finances will shortly be published on the web site.

Highways

It was noted that drains and gulleys in the village have recently been jetted and cleaned.

Moat will again be asked to cut the grass fronting its housing in Maldon Road, and a damaged tree needs replacing at the site.
