c) New SIDS and Solar Panels – Cllr Bishop who was not able to attend the meeting and it was therefore assumed there was no further update at this time

d) The Clerk had investigated the Speedwatch programme and the Council's position on the waiting list. Unfortunately, due to a change in the Speedwatch personnel, there was no access to the records of the previous application made by the Council and the Clerk was advised that the Council would need to re-apply. After much discussion it was agreed that as the first list of volunteers had been drawn up some time ago, a new list should be obtained to ascertain interest and enable us to proceed.
